Joni Ingram, aged 62 years, passed away at Wartrous District Health Complex on Monday, December 2, 2024.

Joni was born in Shellbrook, Sask. on April 18th, 1962 and grew up on the family farm. It was here she developed her love of nature

and people. She attended school in Shellbrook and was involved in various activities including dance, piano, 4H, and various sports. She also developed her ability to create friendships with those around her and all who knew her felt valued and appreciated. She graduated in 1980 and moved to Saskatoon where she found employment in the service industry, management, and found her niche at Sherbrooke Community Centre where she worked as a care aid. It was here she flourished with her ability to make residents feel respected. In 1981, she married Brent Ingram and later moved to Tisdale and finally to Imperial, Sask. in 1983. Here, she began work at the hospital as a care aid where her skills in interpersonal relationships created lasting friendships. Throughout the years she was involved in the community as a coach, Sunday school teacher, librarian, dinner theatre and manager of various sports teams that her children were involved in. She completed her working career at Imperial School as a Teachers Aide from 2001 - 2013.

In 1984, she began as an Emergency Medical Technician for Imperial and District Ambulance, a passion she maintained until her retirement in 2024. Here she was able to

assist and aid many people in Imperial and the surrounding areas. She found joy in travelling through the province following her four sons in their various sporting activities and cultivating new friendships within those sporting social groups.

Nothing warmed her heart more than when she was surrounded by her family and friends. Her happiest place was hearing the laughter created by her family. She often referred to her boys as her happy place.

Joni is survived by her husband Brent Ingram, sons Bryce (Jill) Ingram, (Jack and Brooks), Mark Ingram (Anique ((Nikki)) and Alouette), Keeran (Tyneal) Ingram, Connor (Sarah) Ingram.
