Cathy McMann, aged 65 years of Watrous, Sask., passed away at Royal University Hospital in Saskatoon, Sask., on Monday, January 19th, 2026.

Cathy (Catherine) McMann was born in Rosstern, Saskatchewan to parents (predeceased)

Norman and Helen (Parker) Simpson. She is survived by husband Mark, son Mitchell (wife Jewel, and sons Marcus, Miles and Mayes) of Clavet, Saskatchewan and daughter Christina of Calgary, Alberta.

Early in her childhood they moved to Broadview, Saskatchewan. Cathy quickly formed a tight-knit friend group that made many memories through elementary and high school consisting of basketball, curling, fishing and lake days. Her retirement travel included trips to Victoria, Toronto, Florida, and Arizona, and many camping trips where her and Mark eventually got a seasonal campsite at Blackstrap Lake, spending many days on their boat.

She loved every minute of being a grandma, participating in every activity, including going to rinks to watch hockey, flag football games, pre-school and kindergarten graduations, babysitting, and sleepovers. She loved making crafts, teaching numbers and words, reading books, and cuddles with her grandsons.

Cathy was a motivated, passionate, and caring individual and will be missed and loved by all who crossed her path.
