Terry Miller of Melfort, SK passed away peacefully in his Melfort home on June 10, 2026. Terry was born on October 3, 1965 in the Saskatoon St. Paul's Hospital.

When he was six months old his parents moved to Watrous where he attended both the elementary and high schools.

Terry was an ambitious and a hard worker. He worked in the Watrous Tire Shop while at-

tending high school and later for G. Janzen's Welding. This led him to go for his Welding Certificate and at a later date, for his Certificate in Heavy Duty Mechanics.

In 1987 he married his childhood sweetheart and they moved to Edmonton. About 11 years later they went their own ways but remained friends until Terry's death.

Terry then went up to Ft. Mac and worked there until Covid. It was after this time he decided to move to Saskatchewan. This brought him to the city of Melfort, working in St. Brieux for DryAir Mfg. Corp. until his passing. His health started to fail in November 2024 when he had a stroke.

Terry's favourite pastime was hockey in winter where he played goalie in a senior men's league and was a diehard fan to his favourite NHL teams. In summer, it was his motorcycle – riding as far as Ontario, throughout B.C. and down the

Western U.S. coastline. Family trips that Terry really enjoyed were the downhill skiing and waterskiing, especially in Waskesiu.

Terry is survived by his parents, Allan and Diane and his only brother, Conn. He was predeceased by his grandparents, Ted and Helen Miller of Duval and Ben and Mary Klatt of Strasbourg and his Uncle Darwin (Marlene) Klatt of Lacombe, Alta.
